Love with Lavender Scent definitely stands out within the romance genre by going beyond the traditional love story.

kshit Sandhu, Manager of Format Acquisitions & Sales at Calinos Entertainment, joined us to discuss Calinos's 25th-year anniversary, the success of their new series *Love with Lavender Scent*, and the continued global popularity of *Farah*. He also shared Calinos's goals for ATF 2024, emphasizing their focus on expanding into the Asian market and exploring co-production opportunities to bring more Turkish narratives to international audiences.

Calinos recently celebrated its 25th anniversary at MIPCOM with a special event. How was your experience there, and what can you tell us about the celebration?

The celebration in Cannes was a wonderful tribute to Calinos Entertainment's achievements. It felt meaningful with the launch of *Hidden Garden*, where Firat Gülgen and the cast shared heartfelt insights into the project. A unique highlight was the "wish box", where guests contributed wishes that will be woven into the series' storyline. The evening beautifully captured Calinos' legacy and its commitment to Turkish drama on a global stage.

You've recently added a new romance series to your catalog. Could you tell us a bit about *Love with Lavender Scent*?

To answer your question, *Love with Lavender Scent* is a captivating romance series that weaves together complex relationships and hidden pasts within a small Romanian village. Set in Podişor, a community where time seems to stand still and residents live by their own rules, the story brings to life a rich tapestry

of secrets and evolving connections. At its core is Anda, a respected family doctor who, after escaping an abusive marriage, has built a life of strength and resilience for herself and her daughter. Her life is upended with the arrival of Stefan, a former football star who unexpectedly inherits her family property through a twist of fate tied to her father's dark past...

Love with Lavender Scent's first two episodes, aired on October 31, 2024, attracted over 1.2 million viewers nationwide, securing the top position in audience ratings across all viewer categories. What do you think has contributed to its success, and how do you see this series growing in the future?

I think one of the key factors driving its popularity is the way it connects emotionally with

At the heart of Farah is a powerful narrative about a mother's resilience and sacrifice, which resonates universally.

Demet Özdemir and Engin Akyürek's performances have also brought incredible depth to their characters, adding to the show's appeal. Both actors have a strong global following, and their chemistry in *Farah* makes the story even more impactful. In our previous conversation with Firat Gülgen, he mentioned that Calinos is also involved in production. How is that going? Are there any new projects you can share with us?

Beyond distributing Turkish dramas globally, we are now focusing on creating original content that brings fresh stories and voices to the screen. We're also developing a few other projects, though details are still under wraps. The team is enthusiastic about bringing unique, compelling Turkish narratives to an international audience, and there's definitely more to look forward to in the coming year!

Calinos has a rich and diverse catalog. Which genres in your lineup tend to attract the most interest in the Asian market?

In the Asian market, some of the genres that attract most interests are romance, family, and drama genres. Romantic dramas with emotionally compelling storylines have a strong appeal, as they resonate well with audiences looking for relatable, heartfelt narratives. We're also seeing increased interest in thrillers and mini-dramas, as viewers are drawn to high-quality productions with suspenseful and engaging plots. As our catalog expands with international titles, we're excited to introduce more genres to Asian audiences.

After MIPCOM, we're now heading to ATF. Could you share some of Calinos' goals and expectations for ATF?

We're excited about the opportunities Calinos has to strengthen our presence in the Asian market. We're eager to introduce *Hidden Garden* to new audiences and build on the enthusiasm from MIP-COM. Personally, I'm looking forward to seeing the interest in our scripted formats as well as exploring co-production opportunities with Asian partners.

FILMING BEGINS FOR OGM PICTURES' NEW SERIES *ŞEHRAZAT*

ATV'S UPCOMING DRAMA CAN BORCU BEGINS FILMING

Gold Film has teamed up with Nuran Evren Şit, the renowned screenwriter of *Another Self*, for one of its upcoming projects this season, *Mavi Begonvil*. Currently in development, the cast and release date have yet to be confirmed.

BOZDAĞ FILM'S *BİR ZAMANLAR İSTANBUL*, STARRING CIHANGIR CEYHAN AND ALINA BOZ, COMING SOON TO TRTI

Bozdağ Film is bringing a new series, *Bir Zamanlar İstanbul* (Once Upon A Time in İstanbul) to TRT1, starring Alina Boz and Cihangir Ceyhan. Alina Boz plays Seher, a fearless journalist in 1990s Istanbul, while Cihangir Ceyhan takes on the role of Ali, whose path crosses with Seher's during their university days. The premiere date for this highly anticipated series is yet to be announced.



NEW COMEDY SERIES *PLATONİK* BEGINS PRODUCTION, STARRING KEREM BÜRSİN

The upcoming series *Platonik*, written by Gupse Özay, is set to start production soon. Starring Öykü Karayel, Kerem Bürsin, and Özay herself, the show follows Gülten (Özay) and her sister Nedret (Karayel) as they navigate life at their family's hotel in Çeşme.

When the charming businessman Kaan (Bürsin) arrives in Çeşme with secret plans to take over the hotel, an amusing rivalry springs up between the sisters, unaware of his true intentions. Kaan's presence not only spices up family dynamics but also brings unexpected fun to the lives of the hotel's guests and staff.





APOLLON BY DAY ATHENA BY NIGHT WINS ASIAN FUTURE BEST FILM AWARD AT 37TH TOKYO FILM FESTIVAL

Emine Yıldırım's first feature-length film Apollon by Day Athena by Night celebrated a major success at the 37th Tokyo Film Festival, winning the Asian Future Best Film Award. As the only entry from Türkiye, the film generated significant interest, with tickets selling out days in advance.

Director Emine Yıldırım, along with lead actors Ezgi Çelik and Barış Gönenen, editor Selda Taşkın, sound designer Metin Bozkurt, and producer Dilde Mahalli, expressed their gratitude for the enthusiastic response at the festival. The award was presented by a jury including Indonesian director Nia Dinata, Japanese festival director Yamashita Koyo, and Japanese director Yokohama Satoko during the closing ceremony on November 6.

The jury praised the film as "an original work, with standout performances that add layers of depth to the story. Visually captivating, it seamlessly connects past and present with a refreshing perspective."

Accepting the award on stage, Emine Yıldırım couldn't hide her excitement. In her speech, she shared insights into the film's creation: "This film is the product of true collaboration between artists in front of and behind the camera, who poured their hearts and souls into it with me. I owe my gratitude to my actors and the entire crew, especially my lead actress, Ezgi Çelik, with her lionhearted spirit, and my producer, Dilde Mahalli, with her wisdom. Despite all the challenges, we completed this film thanks to the solidarity of women. I dedicate this award to all the women of the Middle East."



Creating a Fairytale: Emre Kabakuşak on *The Nightfall*

he Nightfall, starring Su Burcu Yazgı Coşkun and Burak Deniz, has captured viewers' attention from its very first episode. We sat down with the show's director, Emre Kabakuşak, to discuss his directing journey from Remember Darling to The Nightfall and much more.

I'd like to start by talking about your new series. *The Nightfall* has been quite successful in the ratings so far. We'd love to hear more about the show from your perspective.

The Nightfall is about the struggle of two people who fall in love at first sight and try to make the impossible happen. A police officer who requests a transfer to seek revenge falls in love with the daughter of the man who had his father shot, and our journey begins with the most genuine emotions and unexpected surprises.

The Nightfall has been very well-received, and it also has a strong cast. The story explores new directions with each episode. What do you think are the elements that make the show so beloved by the audience?

I think the audience wants to see something relatable, genuine, and natural. We combined visuals that fit the story with a straightforward narrative. This approach was appreciated by viewers, they found our work sincere. They connected with the actors, took sides in the character conflicts, and that made what we created engaging to watch.

The series started in Denizli and is now continuing in İstanbul. Your choice of locations and use of music have also been widely praised. What can you tell us about these aspects?

All of it is the result of extensive efforts. Before choosing Denizli, we visited and examined many places, including Adana, Mersin, Tarsus, and other locations in the west. We decided that Denizli and its surroundings were the most fitting for the story we wanted to tell and the atmosphere we aimed to create. I'm glad we went there; the working conditions were very favorable, and visually, it provided a setting that really satisfied us. Our music is by Alp Yenier, with whom I previously worked on *The Ambassador's Daughter*. He's an artist whose intuition and sensibility I trust deeply, and his contributions are clearly evident. He understands perfectly touch the scenes I shoot and grasps exactly what kind of scene I'm aiming to create with each shot.

Before *The Nightfall* started, there was some criticism about the age gap between Burak Deniz and Su Burcu Yazgı Coşkun. After the first episode aired, there were also discussions about the cave scene. As the director of the series, how do you respond to these criticisms?

Criticism of my work has always had a positive effect on me. The story we're telling doesn't need to have an exact equivalent in real life; we're creating a kind of fairytale, selling dreams. We're not here to present absolute truths, deliver public service announcements, or act as thought leaders. Of course, there will be criticism, as long as it's within the bounds of logic and reason. If we're telling the love story of a 32-yearold police officer and a 21-year-old young Yörük girl, then Burak and Yazgı are perfect for it! They're both so talented and intelligent; always bringing something extra to their roles. With such high awareness, every scene they perform sparks reactions, which is completely normal. The script finds ways to advance its story, and the ablution scene in the cave was just an element to bring the characters together, and it turned out to be a beautiful scene.

The Nightfall has started its global journey at MIPCOM, one of the most important content fairs. How do you feel about the show's potential success internationally? What do you think awaits the series in this regard?

We create our work to be successful, so seeing it appreciated

and enjoyed is a wonderful feeling. As a country, we're already in a good position in the international TV series market, and being part of that presentation, reaching a global audience, and being watched motivates us to do even better.

Since the beginning of your career, you've been involved in memorable projects on Turkish television and have worked with many prominent directors. know you studied at university in Niğde and then began working as an assistant, but I'd love to hear about your journey into the industry from your perspective.

I started in the industry as an assistant in 2003. After that, I set a goal for myself, to become a director within five years, and my first step toward that was with the series *Remember Darling*, where I began directing. Then came other series and film projects...

Remember Darling was one of the most important and valuable series in our television history. Following that, you directed memorable series like To Better Days, War of the Roses, and Lifeline. Turkish television has undergone a significant transformation, especially over the past decade. You've spent many years in the world of television and cinema, and I believe



you have a strong intuition about audience preferences and expectations. How do you view this change? What have you observed?

Yes, each project I've done is very valuable to me. With each one, I learned a lot, gained experience, made mistakes, and tried to learn from them. I'm still learning, trying to understand, to find my own absolute truths because what we do is actually a very subjective job. Everyone has their own perspective, their own story, and their own way of telling it. In the past, episodes were shorter, audiences could watch without getting bored and engage more deeply. Now, the episodes are very long, sometimes slow, with a slower pace... It has become challenging to keep viewers engaged and watching.

I'd also like to touch on audience preferences. What do you think viewers want to watch these days?

I think viewers want to empathize. They want to find heroes, to celebrate with the characters they choose, to feel joy, to see resilience even in sorrow, and to watch people overcome challenges. They want to see strength. In dramas, want to feel grateful, to see that their own situation isn't so bad, and to see what else is out there. They want to be intrigued, to see their predictions come true, and to have that satisfaction of saying, "I knew it." But, of course, that's just my perspective.

In the TV series industry, casting and script selection are crucial. Great scripts can fail due to poor casting and vice versa. As a director, what criteria do you pay attention to when choosing scripts and actors? I am sure you have some special instincts you developed in this process.

Everything must be in harmony; a great story can be wasted with poor casting and direction. In my projects, I first look at what kind of cast the script requires: the type, talent, and energy. Then comes a rigorous audition process, working and reading scenes until we find the right fit, and finally, aligning the cast like puzzle pieces to ensure cohesion.

You've directed *Bride of Beirut*, an adaptation of *Bride of Istanbul*. What did this experience bring you? It must not be so easy to direct a series in a different country, with local actors, and in a different language.

It was a project I experienced for the first time, and I was initially very anxious. During the preparation process, I realized how universal our work is and how cinema is based on emotions, a common language beyond words. Though I heard a different language, I saw the same feelings. After I expressed what I wanted to accomplish, despite the cultural differences, their understanding and sharing in my emotions and excitement led to a successful project.





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




Hits, Misses, and Fresh Starts: A Look at the Türkiye's New TV Season

HOW WILL THESE FRESH RELEASES IMPACT THE ALREADY COMPETITIVE RATINGS SCENE? ONLY TIME WILL TELL, BUT ONE THING IS CERTAIN: TÜRKİYE'S TV INDUSTRY CONTINUES TO CAPTIVATE AUDIENCES WITH PLENTY OF EXCITING NEW STORIES.



he rising costs of production in Türkiye led networks to cancel summer series and start the regular season earlier than usual. This year, Turkish dramas began airing as early as September, with a mix of renewed fan-favorites and ambitious new titles produced by the country's leading production companies, all competing for top ratings.

A total of 17 series returned from last season, with 8 new ones kicking off in September and 2 more debuting in October with more shows lined up to premiere in November and December. In the tough ratings competition, some new releases were canceled early, while others turned into big hits, adding to the success of the returning favorites. Let's dive in and take a closer look.

THE STANDOUT NEW SERIES

Among the season's top-performing new dramas, Valley of Hearts, produced by TIMS&B Productions, captured a strong total rating of 4.03 in its premiere. Another buzzworthy title, *The Good and the Bad*, featuring Aras Bulut İynemli, debuted with an impressive 5.49 rating. Meanwhile, the adaptation of Avenida Brasil, retitled Leyla, launched with a respectable 4.87, and ATV's The Nightfall joined the lineup with a debut rating of 4.67. All these new series have successfully maintained their run so far.

October added a few promising new dramas to the lineup. On October 15, *Hidden Garden*, starring Murat Yıldırım and Ebru Şahin, aired its first episode with a rating of 3.36. Another notable series, *The Cost of Lies*, made its debut the same month, securing a rating of 3.88.

OLD BUT GOLD

While fresh stories and cast ensembles draw initial interest, renewed series have shown they still hold a special place in view-



ers' hearts. In the ABC1 category, classics like *One Love* (8.59), *An Anatolian Tale* (6.91), *Blooming Lady* (7.98), *Red Roses* (7.87), *The Shadow Team* (7.22), and *The Ottoman* (6.03) are consistently topping the charts.

In the ABC1 category for October, *The Good and the Bad* joined the top ranks alongside *One Love, An Anatolian Tale, Blooming Lady*, and *Red Roses* in the top three spots, underlining the continued appeal of these beloved series.

CANCELLED SHOWS

Despite a strong lineup, some newcomers fell short in the ratings and ended sooner than anticipated. *Kötü Kan, Güzel Aşklar Diyarı*, and *Loveberry* all wrapped up by their sixth episodes. Meanwhile, the returning series *Taş Kağıt Makas* concluded its second season with only five episodes. The series *Kör Nokta*, starring İsmail Ege Şaşmaz and Rabia Soytürk, also met an early end, ending after just four episodes due to low ratings.



WHAT'S NEXT?

Even with an early start to the season, there are still many new series set to premiere in the coming months. Following the debut of 6 of Us, OGM Pictures is gearing up to launch several highly anticipated shows, including Kral Kaybederse, starring Halit Ergenç, and Şehrazat. The historical drama Şakir Paşa Ailesi: Mucizeler ve Skandallar is also on the way, along with an ambitious Korean adaptation, Aşk Evlilik Boşanma, which is expected to capture significant audience interest.

How will these fresh releases impact the already competitive ratings scene? Only time will tell, but one thing is certain: Türkiye's TV industry continues to captivate audiences with plenty of exciting new stories.

ŞEKİB AVDAGİÇ, PRESIDENT OF ISTANBUL CHAMBER OF COMMERCE (ICOC)

Every country where Turkish series are watched becomes a market for products labeled "Made in Türkiye"

or our ATF Singapore issue, we had the opportunity to sit down with Istanbul Chamber of Commerce President Şekib Avdagiç to discuss the Chamber's strategic vision for 2025 and more.

Avdagiç highlighted ICOC's record-breaking achievements in 2024, including 47 trade fairs across four continents, and outlined ambitious goals for expanding Turkish content and products in the Asian market. With ICOC's continued presence at key events like ATF Singapore, Avdagiç foresees new partnerships that will strengthen ties between Türkiye and Asia, driving mutual growth and opening doors for Turkish businesses worldwide.

How was 2024 for the Istanbul Chamber of Commerce (ICOC)? Could you provide a detailed evaluation of ICOC's activities in various trade fairs across different sectors around the world? At ICOC, our most significant initiative to enhance the competitiveness and productivity of our members has been to take our products and business community to international trade shows, a tradition we have maintained since the 1893 Chicago Fair. Back in those days, we were only able to organize participation in one fair at a time. However, in 2024, we reached a record by organizing 47 trade fairs.

This year has been our most productive yet. Through these 47 trade fairs, we facilitated the participation of 1,300 Turkish companies, providing them with approximately 40,000 square meters of exhibit space to showcase their products and services on an international stage. For example, we set a new record at the Paris SIAL Expo with 294 companies participating and a total exhibition area of 7,983 square meters. Similarly, our national participation in Phase 2 of the Canton Fair saw a three-fold increase compared to the previous year.

In summary, in 2024, we were present at global trade shows across all sectors: from lighting to textiles, promotional products to digital transformation, construction to stationery, TV and film content to mobile communication technologies, composites to automotive. We participated in numerous fairs across 17 different countries on 4 continents.

In 2024, ICOC also participated in numerous global content fairs. What can you share about this year's developments in the export of Turkish content?

First, let me emphasize this: Türkiye's TV industry functions as a driving force for the Turkish economy and continued this praiseworthy role in 2024. The success of our dramas has helped create a billion-dollar industry for Türkiye. Beyond that, it has strengthened Türkiye's global soft power. Research shows that Türkiye is now the world's second-largest exporter of scripted TV series, following the United States. We see that our content exporters play a significant role in the upward trend of our exports. The uniqueness of the Turkish content industry, its emotional depth and the life motifs it portrays, meets Asia's strengths at this fair. I believe that Turkish companies, which have established a solid target audience at ATF Singapore under the principle that "Content is everything," will become a sought-after partner for new successes and collaborations.

In this regard, I think data from Parrot Analytics, a research firm, will be insightful: Between 2020 and 2023, global demand for Turkish dramas rose by 184%, while Korean series saw a 73% increase. Turkish series attract attention even at the script stage, with 80% of them being sold before they even air. Turkish productions have now reached their 18th year in the Middle East and Gulf countries and their 11th year in Latin America. The characters of Turkish series have even become an inspiration for novelists worldwide.

I believe that, alongside the Turkish TV drama and content industry, the pioneering projects and initiatives led by the Istanbul Chamber of Commerce (ICOC) since 2011 have made a significant contribution to achieving this success. Since then, we have been facilitating the participation of companies in various content fairs across Europe, the Middle East, Asia, America, and Africa. I am pleased to say that our efforts, which began with MIPCOM, have helped foster a robust export culture in this field.







In 2024, we participated in Content Americas, MIPTV, NATPE Budapest, MIPCOM, Dubai International Content Market, and ATF Singapore, and we will continue our work at the same pace in 2025.

We're now at ATF, one of the most important fairs for the Asian market. How does ICOC evaluate ATF, and what are your goals for this year's market?

We consider ATF Singapore to be the most significant content fair in the Asian region. For this reason, we are organizing Türkiye's national participation for the 9th time. We see ATF Singapore as the gateway for the Turkish content industry to reach Asian markets. It's a two-way exchange... Because this fair also provides the strongest platform for our content collaborations with Asian countries.

The uniqueness of the Turkish content industry, its emotional depth and the life motifs it portrays, meets Asia's strengths at this fair. I believe that Turkish companies, which have established a solid target audience at ATF Singapore under the principle that "Content is everything," will become a sought-after partner for new successes and collaborations. Therefore, bringing together the Turkish content industry with professionals from the Asian sector is incredibly exciting for us.

Asia is indeed a crucial market for Turkish content. What can you say about our content exports and potential collaborations with Asian countries in other sectors?

I agree with your observation that Asia is an essential market for Turkish content. There are actually two seemingly contrasting reasons for this: Turkish content resonates with global tastes and emotions, appealing to a wide international audience. Secondly, the content Turkish produce have the ability to preserve local values while presenting them with a universal touch. So this is a significant richness...

Undoubtedly, when a society with Asian heritage creates content infused with modern values, and this content reaches the right audience on the right platform, success naturally follows. Türkiye is now acting as a bridge between Asia and Europe in the TV and content sector; not only bringing these two ancient continents together with its young content but also helping to keep them connected.

This, in particular, will enable collaborative production between Asian countries and Türkiye, not only for their own markets but also for a world of 8 billion people. I believe that ATF Singapore will bring us even closer to achieving this goal.

Beyond content exports, we have numerous collaborations and exports across various sectors in Asian countries. Could you provide a general assessment of these as ICOC?

The world has truly become a global village. Despite challenges like the pandemic, the inhabitants of this village rely on one another and must engage



in mutual exchange. The key point here is ensuring that these connections continue uninterrupted, in other words, maintaining the supply chain. For this reason, the Istanbul Chamber of Commerce places great importance on every corner of Asia, from East Asia to Central Asia, South Asia to West Asia. As we strengthen our relations with every country from China to Kazakhstan, we believe that Asia's integration into global trade will contribute to a more equitable world with fairer distribution of wealth.

The export of Turkish content has a very positive impact on many sectors, from fashion to tourism. We're certain that ICOC has observed these effects and outcomes closely. Could you share your insights on how Turkish content influences Turkish exports and other sectors?

Turkish TV series and content are acting as free consultants guiding Turkish businesses to the right markets. Türkiye's soft power serves as a key that opens the doors of global markets for our exports. In other words, every country where Turkish series are watched becomes a market for products labeled "Made in Türkiye." This is because the Turkish content industry vividly shows Türkiye's diverse product and service sectors, from food to technology, automotive to healthcare, to audiences worldwide. As a result, we have a private sector that can export to nearly every country in the world.

We're preparing for a new year. In your opinion, what goals should be set for Turkish content exports in 2025?

In fact, our goals for participation in content fairs, which we've planned together with the industry's stakeholders, clearly outline our targets. Let me tell you this much about the goals: in January 2025, the Istanbul Chamber of Commerce will be organizing participation in a content fair in the United States aimed at the Latin American market. We plan to be present at every quality series fair on every continent, further elevating Türkiye's content industry which serves as a driving force for the country's service industry. Because we believe that just as Türkiye is advancing in industries like manufacturing, agriculture, and technology, it must also continue to grow in the TV series and content sector to engage with the world. When the content industry becomes one of the strongest pillars of Türkiye's global trade ambitions, its achievements will be lasting and unbreakable.

What are ICOC's goals and plans for global fairs and organizations in 2025?

With 142 years of experience and over 800,000 members, the Istanbul Chamber of Commerce is one of the world's two largest chambers. Our long-standing mission and guiding principles remain unchanged: to position the Turkish business community at the heart of global trade and production.

We've set our 2025 global fair participation goals in this spirit. We will continue to be present in every fair and sector where trade, new markets, competition, innovation, and collaboration thrive, alongside Turkish companies. Therefore, in 2025, our Chamber will keep paving the way for Turkish businesses at global fairs and events, helping them reach new heights.


hen I first saw the trailers for *I Am Mother* which begins with the story of a missing child, I'll admit I thought, "Here comes another show that will drown us in sorrow and misery." I even thought to myself, "What a shame; such a great cast, and we probably won't be able to watch it." But after finishing the first episode, I realized I was completely wrong, and I happily admitted my mistake. I love being wrong in such a good way.

The series begins with Karsu and Reha's son, Kuzey, going missing while on the way to İstanbul with his grandmother, Filiz. By the end of the first episode, Kuzey has been found but is now known as Deniz. What we see at the end of the first episode actually represents three years in the story, and that's exactly where everything truly begins.

Karsu, portrayed by Özge Özpirinçci with a naturalness we've sorely missed in TV series is married to Reha, played by Necip Memili with a remarkable intensity that's almost terrifying. By the fifth minute of the show, amid all the drama, we're already wondering, "Why on earth did this woman marry such a man?" Filiz, the grandmother played by Demet Akbağ, not only amplifies the drama of the show but also brilliantly lifts the curtain on it, mischievously raising the humor in every scene she enters.

The story begins when, after finding her son, Karsu discovers her husband has been cheating on her for years with her best friend. She immediately leaves everything behind and heads to İstanbul, moving in with her estranged mother. Actually, she doesn't go straight there; her aunt brings her there, and her mother tells her it's time to put the past behind them and the story unfolds from there. One thing I really appreciate about this series is how quickly things progress, it doesn't drag things out unnecessarily. For example, we don't have to wait five episodes with sad music in the background for Karsu to learn she's been cheated on. My main hope for the rest of the series is that it keeps up this momentum.

I Am Mother is a series filled with both heartbreaking and significant events, yet it somehow gives a sense of calm, making it feel like we're simply watching an ordinary day. I know it sounds contradictory, but once you watch it, you'll see what I mean. For example, Karsu hasn't spoken to her mother Filiz in years because she



lied to her, but the next morning, they have breakfast together as if everything is normal. Later, Filiz goes for Botox, has an allergic reaction, and Karsu rushes her to the hospital in a panic. The next day, over coffee, her mother and aunt exchange glances, wondering how they'll look after the kids if Karsu starts working. Then Reha refuses to pay for the kids' school fees, and all these moments blend in together, just like a slice of everyday life. It's proof that you don't always need grand gestures or dramatic lines to convey meaningful stories, just a storyteller who believes in what they're telling and actors who truly understand their characters.

If you haven't started watching *I Am Mother* yet, you can jump in at any point and I promise that you won't feel left out.








LOVE WITH LAVENDER SCENT



In this small village, she raised her child alone and became a respected family doctor, essential to the community. FARAH

Adapted from the award-winning Argentinian series La Chica Que Limpia; Farah is the story of an Iranian woman, who had to run away from her country and is struggling to live in İstanbul, working as a cleaning lady in order to maintain the treatment of her son. Farah was one of the brightest students at one of Iran's leading medical schools, until months before she had to flee. But she and her entire family ruthlessly pay the price for a man's failure to reciprocate her love, and Farah flees to Türkiye, unaware that she is pregnant with a boy. Seven years later, this bright futured woman is forced to work as a cleaning lady in order to provide for herself and her son. Farah's son Kerim has a disease called "balloon boy disease"... One night while cleaning, Farah witnesses a mafia murder. She begs to the hitman Tahir to let her go promising to keep her mouth shut and offers to clean the murder scene. The following day, Farah finds out that the victim of the crime is a policeman; a dear friend to her neighbor Gönül and her big brother Chief Inspector Mehmet (Firat Tanış). Farah decides to testify and goes to the police station where she meets Tahir, who has been detained by Mehmet. Leaving the station at once, Farah decides to leave the country, however, fate has its own way and she suddenly finds herself at a hospital. While she tries to get away, a deadly injured man is being brought to the E.R. Farah intervenes in order to rescue him, unaware of the fact, that the man she tries to rescue is the leader of the mafia and Tahir's boss Ali Galip. This instinctive act takes her to the middle of the mafia-police war and an unpredictable love with her hunter Tahir, at the first season. With Farah's son Kerim, all three together, create a family, against all odds around them. But the love between Farah & Tahir will be tested even harder at the second season when Behnam, the father of Kerim who was known as dead, arrives Istanbul to get his so-called "family" back.



EGO

The Koraslan Family is one of the most well-known families in tourism industry in Türkiye. Sibel and Tuncay are both involved in their family business. On the the other hand, the Öztürks are a middle-class family. Burhan being the father, who lost his beloved wife 2 years ago, his daughter Elif and son Arda. Elif is engaged to Erhan, a frank and brave man who works in the finance department at the Koraslan Family's firm. Burhan loves Erhan as his own son and relies heavily on him. When Erhan asks for money to invest on the stock market, he hypothecates his house in return for a huge loan. Things turn for the worse and Erhan loses the all money. The Öztürk Family could lose their house unless Erhan mends the situation. Meanwhile Sibel, who got unexpectedly abandoned by the man, who she had fallen in love with for the first time in her life, suddenly learns that she has a cyst in her womb and if she doesn't conceive soon, she will not be able to bear children. Elif, Erhan and Sibel's lives will completely change, when Sibel decides to get pregnant with Erhan's baby and makes an indecent proposal in the amount of 3 million



TYCOON / TAJKUN

Vladan Simonović is a tycoon, hated in Serbia because of the wealth he gained during the disintegration of Yugoslavia in the 1990s. Although he was able to run his company from the shadows, and to some extent the economy of the entire country, the politicians now in power, put him on a kind of pillar of shame, using him to strengthen their political authority. At the same time, the same politicians are cooperating with Simonović's rivals and plan to turn themselves and people from their closest surroundings into a new class of tycoons who are unconditionally loyal to them, with a seemingly clean past. Therefore, the assassination attempt on Simonović will not make him a victim in the eyes of politicians and the media under their control. On the contrary, that attack will make him even more isolated and vulnerable, making him conduct the investigation into his assassination attempt by himself. He is a persecuted man, forced to take drastic measures to preserve himself and his company. Besides his public and secret enemies, he is in conflict with his son, but also with the rest of the family, which is only kept together by his wealth.



THE CLAN / KLAN

The murder of Tigar, the biggest mafia boss in this part of Europe, shook the Serbian underground to its foundations. Many want to take his place. The cards are open again. Everyone wants their piece of booty and they are ready to do anything to win it... On the margins of that world, Shock and Pasha, provincials and not overly successful petty thieves, are just beginning their careers which will take them to unimaginable levels... This is their path; their story.



ALERT SQUAD

Behind each disappearance lies a hidden reality. Every single minute counts when the Missing Persons Unit is working a case. Driven by hope, bound by courage and determination, the team investigates with one clear objective: to recover the missing alive. *Alert Squad* is a policedriven series built on human drama. With its 3rd season it was awarded by The Academy of Canadian Cinema and TV as "The Best Annual Series" at the 38th Prix Gémeaux Awards.



FORBIDDEN FRUIT

Ender, a woman from the high society and wife of successful businessman Halit Argun, hires Yıldız Yılmaz as her husband's personal waitress in order to seduce her husband, so that Ender can get Halit's assets after their divorce. But, Yıldız betrays Ender and exposes her plan. When Halit learned the truth; he divorces Ender, leaving her penniless and discredited. After their divorce Yıldız and Halit get married. This is is the beginning of an endless war between Ender and Yıldız; which will continue for seasons.







VALLEY OF HEARTS

At a young age, Sumru abandoned her newborn twins without even holding them. She moved to Cappadocia with her mother, where she married Samet, a wealthy and prominent figure in the city's tourism industry. They had two children. Samet also has a son from his first marriage, Cihan. Growing up under difficult circumstances the twins. Nuh and Melek, fueled by hatred for the mother who abandoned them, find out their mother's identity. They come to Cappadocia to claim what they believe they are entitled to and confront their mother. Caught off guard, Sumru denies everything, but she is aware that it's only a matter of time before the secret she has hidden is revealed. Things are also complicated at the Sansalan mansion. Sumru's widowed sister-in-law lives at the mansion with her daughter Sevilay. Her goal is to marry her daughter off to her nephew Cihan and secure their future. Also, Samet supports this plan. As the twins pursue what they believe is rightfully theirs from their mother, Melek crosses paths with Cihan, and Nuh encounters Sevilay. From the first moment, Cihan is deeply affected by Melek and can't get her out of his mind, even as he finds himself on the brink of a forced marriage. Meanwhile, as Sevilay tries to oppose the marriage on her own, she crosses paths with Nuh. Although Sumru tries to keep the children she rejected away from her family. Melek and Nuh will gradually infiltrate both the family and the hearts of Cihan and Sevilay. As Samet's health problems worry the entire family, his old enemy, Tahsin, waits in the shadows, ready to take revenge for the past.



LOVE AND PRIDE

The Köksoys live in an ancestral mansion as a wealthy and rooted family. With three daughters, the family is sinking and on the verge of losing everything. In a state of great panic, they contemplate how to escape the impending disaster when Tolga enters their lives like a savior. He is the heir to a wealthy and established family. If one of the daughters marries him, life will continue as it used to, affluent and secure. The idea is considered forthe eldest daughter, Mercan, to marry him. However, Mercan rebels against this imposition, finding Tolga excessively arrogant and frivolous. Despite Tolga and Mercan being attracted to each other, Mercan's high pride and Tolga's spoiled attitude build thick walls between them. However, unlike Mercan, there is someone who desires him passionately- the middledaughter, Gül. Tolga shifts his focus from Mercan to Gül. As they drift towards marriage, Tolga's heart remains with Mercan. Mercan, too, has fallen in love with him. The girls' mother insists on a quick marriage because Tolga will rescue them from the financial crisis. However, Tolga is just as submerged as them and desires this marriage for his own salvation.



DECEPTION

Güzide Yenersoy is a respectable family court judge living in Istanbul. With a marriage of 30 years and two children, Güzide Yenersoy has what could be described as the epitome of a perfect family. Her husband, Tarık, is an experienced and successful lawyer, running his own law firm. Her son, Ozan, is a construction engineer working at a prestigious company, while her daughter, Oylum, is studying medicine in the Netherlands, upon her mother's insistence. From the outside, Yenersoy family has a picture-perfect life based on trust and love, but the truth is completely different from this false reality. Although everything seems to be going well, Güzide is not aware that the events buried in the past will come to light again. Every member of her family, whom she loves and dedicates her life to, is lying to Güzide. She does not know that Ovlum has made the decision to go to the USA to realize her dream of studying modern dance. While Oylum is counting down for the day she will go to New York, her family friend Tolga, whom she met by chance at the airport, becomes her partner in secret. Oylum is not the only one lying to Güzide. After not receiving the promotion he was expecting, Ozan follows his friend's advice of investing in crypto money, but he gets himself into huge trouble by sinking his father's friend's entrusted money. However, her husband is the one who commits the betrayal that will change Güzide's life forever. Tarık has a second family, which he has been keeping secret for five years. When her husband's betraval is revealed, Güzide finds herself confronting the reality that her life has been a lie.



LIKE THERE'S NO TOMORROW

The meeting of popular and successful actress Manolya with experienced journalist Hakan for an interview changes both of their lives. In the brief time they spend together, they lay out secrets they have never shared with anyone else, their past relationships, and the failures within those relationships. As Manolya and Hakan grow closer while discussing love, hate, relationships, sex, jealousy, and the spirit of the times, they seek ways to establish honest and open communication, only to realize that it's not as easy as it seems.





POISON IVY

Macide, the daughter of a poor family who has studied psychology and is not happy in business life and seeks to heal others, falls in love with the elder brother of Ahmet, Kazım Işık, who is known as the smartest and the most successful businessman in the country. She has just met and fallen in love with the man with a morbid passion. Moreover, Kazım lşık is married to Nermin. Macide's love is not unrequited. Kazım passionately embraces Macide, who is by his side at his weakest moment... But will he be able to protect her from the cruelty of the rich and powerful life he created? Will Macide be able to preserve the purity, innocence and sensitivity she had when she first met Kazım? Or worse yet, when everyone makes her a "queen" out of false reverence... This is the story of a young woman who falls in love for the first time on her way to heal herself by healing others, following the healing she received from her father. The story of a man who has everything he wants in life, but perhaps mostly for this reason, looking for a companion in unhappiness and loneliness... Poison Ivy is a love story that tells that when two souls find each other despite the whole world, even themselves. Everything stands in front of them but still, they meet. However, no one can illuminate another's darkness.

TUZAK

Tuzak tells the story of three siblings Mahir, Umut and Umay whose springs of life were taken from them. Who is bad, who is real, who is fake? In such a mixed-up world, three siblings Umut, Mahir and Umay who came together for a common purpose, find out that they don't have the bond they thought they had. 






VENDETTA


THE FATHER

TELEVISION SERIES, WHICH HAVE AN EXPANDING MARKET BOTH DOMESTICALLY AND INTERNATIONALLY, ARE A POWERFUL TOOL FOR DESTINATION MARKETING AS THEY BRING HISTORICAL AND TOURIST SITES TO VIEWERS' ATTENTION, ULTIMATELY TRANSFORMING THEM INTO TOURISTS.







ourist travel and visiting various locations are activities people choose to experience unique moments and escape from everyday stress. Tourist destinations can be defined as a blend of tourism products that provides consumers with integrated experiences. Recently, films and TV series have become popular platforms for increasing the visibility of tourist sites and boosting their brand value. The locations chosen for films and series often spark greater interest in these places, leading to organized tours that include these newly popularized routes.

Mainstream media plays a significant role, particularly in the initial stages of building and spreading the image of tourist destinations. Television and tourism-specific thematic media are instrumental in creating awareness and shaping perceptions of a destination. The images produced through these channels increase awareness and set expectations about the destination. Film-induced tourism involves featuring elements of tourist sites, such as natural beauty, historical landmarks, and cultural events, within movie or TV show content, therefore encouraging the planning of tourism activities in these locations. Film-induced tourism contributes to the economic, social, and cultural structure of a region by generating tourist flow. Tours are often



organized to the film or series locations, whether real sites or studios to bring tourist income to the area. While films are not created specifically to promote tourism, it is widely accepted that films, particularly those that appeal to certain audiences, raise awareness of locations and destinations, thereby attracting potential tourists.

The characteristics of a destination where a series is produced, whether natural, historical, or literary, can be a key factor in promoting tourism activities in that location. Locations seen on screen make viewers more familiar with these destinations, encouraging them to visit. This type of marketing helps transform places into tourism brands. In particular, the recent international sales performance of Turkish series, along with the popularity of the actors, the items and clothes they use, and the locations where the stories are filmed, has created a substantial business volume.





With series like An Istanbul Fairytale, Brave and Beautiful, Second Chance, Flames of Desire, Love for Rent, and Orphan Flowers, İstanbul has become widely recognized; Behzat Ç. has brought attention to Ankara; The Mansion with Vines to Ürgüp; An Anatolian Tale to Sivrihisar; Bride of Istanbul to Bursa; Sevdaluk and Lifeline to the Black Sea region; Berivan, Beyond the Clouds, and Sila to Mardin; Lady's Farm, New Bride, Ramo and Bitter Lands to Adana; and Daydreaming, Last Summer, Familya, and Waves to the Aegean coast. Among these, perhaps the most iconic location remains the mansion popularized by The Mansion with Vines, which is still a prominent stop on tour itineraries. The audience's appreciation and attachment to series and characters increase interest in the locations where these stories unfold. While many series settings are typically within istanbul's boundaries, the trend is gradually shifting toward cultural, historical, and touristic sites in different cities, enriching the atmosphere of these narratives. Sometimes, these stunning visuals overshadow the storyline itself, drawing increased interest to the destination and fostering new travel routes in domestic tourism.

Television dramas not only aim to appeal to audiences but also seek to shape this preferences. This goal is a product of an economic-political perspective. Destination marketing is a comprehensive effort that contributes significantly to the economic, social, and cultural structure of a country. Film-induced tourism proves to be effective, lasting, and persuasive in destination marketing, encouraging viewers to visit these places. Therefore, official institutions need to support film-induced tourism by providing funding, setting up filming locations, and contributing to the national and international promotion of cities, regions, and countries. Considering



the recent surge in our series exports, specially to over 150 countries, including Latin American nations, the Middle East, Eastern Europe, Turkic Republics, Asia, Russia, Africa, Spain, and Portugal, our series have become a powerful tool for cultural and tourism marketing.

Using TV series, the most popular television content, for cultural and tourism promotion is an effective method of reaching audiences. When utilizing series, it's essential to incorporate tourist sites into the storyline and choose locations that align with the dramatic narrative, highlighting their historical and cultural features. In episodes, visually captivating locations should be used in scenes that drive the storyline toward resolution and keep the audience engaged. Integrating local expressions and descriptions within the dramatic narrative would help create an authentic portrayal, making it a powerful promotional tool. Content creators, public officials responsible for cultural policy, and local authorities should collaborate to encourage projects that spotlight destinations. Television series, which have an expanding market both domestically and internationally, are a powerful tool for destination marketing as they bring historical and tourist sites to viewers' attention, ultimately transforming them into tourists.



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
